

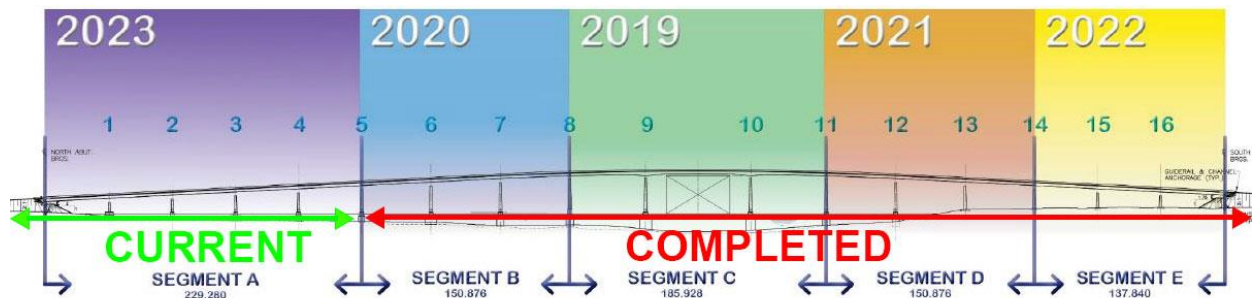

Public Notification – **Extended Duration Full Mainline Closures**

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is to notify you that the two **Extended-Duration Full Mainline Closures** of Highway 49 at the Bay of Quinte Skyway Bridge scheduled on **October 16, 2023** from **9:00 PM to 11:00 PM** and on **October 17, 2023** from **12:00 AM to 2:00 AM** has been cancelled due to unforeseen equipment issues.

The closure has been rescheduled for the back-up date of **October 17, 2023** from **9:00 PM to 11:00 PM** and on **October 18, 2023** from **12:00 AM to 2:00 AM**. This closure is intended for the jacking of the bridge to install permanent bearings.



During these time periods the highway will be closed, and no traffic will be permitted to pass over the bridge. Please refer to the following website for the Glenora Ferry as an alternative route:
